winget install Microsoft.AppInstaller
```

1. Download App Installer + Dependencies:

- Paste this Microsoft Store link:

```
arduino

```

- Select **"Retail"** and click the checkmark.

2. Download the following (latest versions):

- Microsoft.UI.Xaml
- VCLibs (VC++ Runtime)
- AppInstaller.appxbundle

3. Install via PowerShell:

```
powershell
Add-AppxPackage -Path "C:\path\to\AppInstaller.appxbundle"
```

If there are dependency errors, install the .appx files for **VCLibs** and **XAML** first using:

```
powershell
Add-AppxPackage -Path "C:\path\to\Microsoft.VCLibs.x64.14.00.appx"
Add-AppxPackage -Path "C:\path\to\Microsoft.UI.Xaml.appx"
```

Alternative: Extract and Install Audirvana Manually (Advanced)

If your system completely blocks .appxbundle, you may:

- Use **MakeAppx.exe** or **7-Zip** to extract the contents
 - Run the underlying .exe inside the bundle — not guaranteed to work, but sometimes does.

Summary Recommendation for GLD 1.0:

- Try installing **App Installer** manually as above.
- If GLD 1.0 is using **Windows 10 LTSC**, ensure all **UWP dependencies** are present.
